

## **Interested in writing a Practitioner Application for the *Journal of Healthcare Management*?**

The *Journal of Healthcare Management* is seeking individuals interested in writing a Practitioner Application (PA) for research articles appearing in the journal. The PA is written by a *practicing healthcare executive* for the practicing healthcare executive in order to make the concepts and findings of a research article more pertinent to the practitioner\* by offering insights and recommendations on applying the concepts to actual organizational situations. Authors of PAs appearing in the *Journal of Healthcare Management* will receive 2 points from ACHE's Recognition Program.

The Practitioner Application:

- Is written by an ACHE affiliate, preferably a Fellow, who is not affiliated with the author(s) of the article or the research site;
- Is approximately 500 words;
- Includes examples of the practitioner's own experiences with the concepts in the article, if applicable;
- Offers ways of implementing the concepts on a practical basis;
- Mentions references or citations or current trends, discussion, practice, or literature on the concepts in the article, and
- Does not promote a method, models, organization, or group to benefit the writer's own interests. (A signed conflict-of-interest statement is required.)

\*A “practitioner” is someone who works in a healthcare delivery setting, such as a member of the C-suite (e.g., CEO, COO, CFO, CIO, CMO, CNO, senior vice president), a director, a vice president, or a department executive or manager.
