### **BG DAVID A. RUBENSTEIN, FACHE, NOMINATED CHAIRMAN-ELECT OF AMERICAN COLLEGE OF HEALTHCARE EXECUTIVES**

**CHICAGO, December 12, 2006**—Brigadier General David A. Rubenstein, FACHE, U.S. Army, Heidelberg, Germany, has been nominated as the 2007–2008 Chairman-Elect of the American College of Healthcare Executives, an international professional society of 30,000 healthcare executives.

The election will take place at the Council of Regents Meeting during ACHE's 50th Congress on Healthcare Leadership in New Orleans held March 19–22. If elected, Rubenstein will serve the first part of a three-year term in ACHE's consecutive chairmanship offices: Chairman-Elect, Chairman and Immediate Past-Chairman.

Board certified in healthcare management and an ACHE Fellow, Rubenstein previously served as an ACHE Governor. Prior to becoming a Governor, he served as the ACHE Regent for the Army—Western Region from 2000 to 2002.
