GROUND TRANSPORTATION

The Arizona Grand Resort is located approximately 8 miles from the Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport. The following modes of transportation are available from the airport and rates quoted are subject to change.

SHUTTLE

Shuttle service is provided by AAA Sedan and is \$25.00 one way from Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport.

TAXI

Taxicabs are available at the airport near the baggage claim area. The fare to/from the hotel is approximately \$35-40.

CAR

From Sky Harbor Airport:

Take the AZ-153 S towards I-10/AZ-143.
Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto EAST UNIVERSITY DR.
Turn RIGHT onto AZ-143 S/HOHOKAM EXPWY.
AZ-143 S turns into 48th ST.
Take 48th St. to BASELINE RD.
Turn LEFT onto BASELINE RD.
Drive 2 blocks.
Turn RIGHT onto S. Arizona Grand Parkway.

From East Valley:

Take US-60 W towards PHOENIX.
Take the I-10 E exit on the left towards TUCSON.
Keep RIGHT at the fork in the ramp.
Turn RIGHT onto W BASELINE RD.
Drive 1 block.
Turn LEFT onto S. Arizona Grand Parkway.

From Car Rental Station at Sky Harbor Airport:

Exit the Car Rental Center and turn left onto Sky Harbor Circle South.
Turn RIGHT onto Buckeye Road.
Stay in the right lane and turn right onto the I-10 East Freeway.
Stay on I-10 East until exit 155, Baseline Road.
Turn RIGHT onto Baseline Road.
Turn LEFT onto S. Arizona Grand Parkway Phoenix.

AIRLINE DISCOUNT INFORMATION
